The Scout Association of Mongolia organizes two main types of jamborees based on traditional scouting methods:

- National Jamboree – A domestic gathering for Mongolian scouts
- International Jamboree – A regional event involving scouts from other countries



We are currently preparing to host the 3rd International Jamboree in 2026. Previously, we successfully organized this event in 2012 and 2016. This upcoming jamboree will feature a more modern and innovative approach, with a strong focus on youth participation, enhanced international collaboration, and the celebration of Mongolia's unique traditions and cultural heritage.

## FOLLOWING THE GREAT KHAN STEPS


Chinggis Khaan, was the ruler who united the Mongol province in 1206 and founded the Great Mongol Empire. His legacy spans half the world, shaping history in ways that continue to influence global cultures today.

Chinggis Khaan is believed to have been born in 1162 in Deluun Boldog, a place located in the Dadal sum of Khentii province, near the banks of the Onon River. Khentii province holds significant historical importance to Chinggis Khaan,, as it was the land where he spent his childhood and youth. It was in this area that he formed his first group of warriors and began his struggle to unite the Mongol tribes. In 1206, Chinggis Khaan established the Khuraldai on Kherlengiin Khuduu Aral in Khentii province, which marked the foundation of the Great Mongol Empire.




## FOLLOWING THE GREAT KHAN STEPS

Nestled in the northeastern region of Mongolia, Khentii Province is a land of majestic mountains, endless steppes, and sacred history.

It is best known as the home of Dadal soum, the birthplace of Genghis Khan, where Mongolia's history and pride were born. Rich in natural beauty and cultural legacy, Khentii stands as a timeless symbol of the nation's spirit and identity.

Khentii experiences a harsh northern steppe climate, characterized by severe, cold winters and short, hot, and rainy summers.



### **FOLLOWING THE GREAT KHAN'S STEP**
